Our Mission Statement reads:

"To provide the best possible framework in which slo-pitch is played, safely and at a high calibre, while fostering good sportsmanship among participants."

To ensure we meet our goal of providing an enjoyable and social atmosphere where competitive games may be played in the spirit of good sportsmanship, our players are expected to comply with certain standards of behavior.

All players shall:

1. Respect the game, play fairly and follow its rules and regulations.
2. Accept judgment decisions made by umpires and Managers during the game.
3. Not use any intoxicating substances during the course of the game, nor appear to be in an intoxicated condition.
4. Demonstrate good sportsmanship and ethical behavior before, during and after games.
5. Respect the privilege and rules of using public facilities.

It is incumbent upon Team Managers and League Executive to oversee the league, safeguard these principles and take appropriate and corrective action when they become aware of such instances as:

- Abuse (including verbal, physical and emotional),
- Disparaging remarks,
- Intimidating, unethical or threatening behavior,
- Violent reaction towards an official, opponent, team mate or spectator.
